### **Train Services:**

The Standard Day Return from Stevenage costs around £17.00 and is valid on all services. This will get you as far as the terminal at King's Cross. Journey taking around 20-25 minutes.

To use buses and the London Underground, you'll need a day pass (One Day Travel card) costing around £20.00 - £25.00 ( This includes the journey from Stevenage to London Kings Cross)

There is a 6-zone system in London, Zone 1 covering the West End and City, Zone 2 covering the inner suburbs, Zones 3-6 covering the Outer suburbs

Prices for just underground (Not inc overground) are as follows:

Peak Day Travelcard Zones 1 to 6 - £14.80

Off-peak Day Travel card Zones 1 to 6 - £7.50
